PROJECT TIMELINE

- **September 2023-** Carroll County Jail inmates are identified as bike recipients for the ReCyCled bike co-op as transportation is a challenge upon release
- **August 2023** – Discussions with the Jail go further, why couldn't we introduce PBT into the Jail?
- **August 2023** – Project is presented to and approved by the Carroll County Commissioners with classroom space provided.
- **September 2023-** Project/budget is approved by the CCRCC
- **October 2023-** PBT approves and caters a program to meet the needs of the Jail and CCAE
- **October/November 2023-** Classroom equipment/supplies arrive
- **December 2023-** The first class begins!

PROJECT BIKE TECH COURSE

- The PBT course is designed to introduce individuals to the many career pathways within the vast bike industry as well as prepare them for entry-level positions as bike technicians with a concentration in:
 - Career preparation and development
 - Technical and mechanical skill development, shop safety, proper use of tools and bike and tool vocabulary.



CLASS DETAIL

- Eligible inmates are now able to participate in a certified bike technician course through CCAE using the PBT curriculum.
- While going through the curriculum, students are building brand new bikes as well as servicing used bikes that are then donated for free to other inmates and folks in need throughout the communities.
- Upon course completion, students receive a certificate listing the skills they've learned, a serviced bike for themselves should they choose, help with resume writing and even help securing employment upon release.



INMATE ELIGIBILITY

- Inmates must be classified as minimum security through an evaluation process completed by the Jail.
- Inmates must be sentenced to a nonviolent, nonsexual crime.
- Inmates must be and stay discipline free.
- Inmates are not allowed to work or attend anything outside the building for a minimum of 30 days after they are sentenced for acclimation purposes.
